I. INTRODUCTION

In addition to the existing system of annual awards at the state and district level, the state has instituted a continuous system of recognition, called Khaas Shiksha, to celebrate its Teachers, Head Teachers (HT's), Head Masters (HM's), Principals etc. who have undertaken initiatives of their own accord to make their students learn better. These nominations are received will be made by the BRCCs/BEEOs of the block monthly, based on the schedule distributed to them.

As with any other line of work, it is imperative to motivate and encourage good performance in teaching and education. A well-functioning system of recognition has twofold advantages:

- It encourages well-performing employees to keep up the good work by catering to the human need for recognition.
- It inspires other employees to work harder in the pursuit of the same recognition.
- Boost morale of high-performing employees who deliver results.
- Encourage innovation and independent initiative by employees (at all levels) to improve quality of education for children
- Realign long term focus on output (LLOs) but also recognize input efforts through continuous recognition

II. METHODOLOGY:

- Based on the school reviews conducted, the BRCCs/BEEOs are required to nominate teachers from their respective blocks
- The state has created simple digital procedure for block officials to submit nominations which has been made available on the DEE Website:
- They are required to fill a simple Nomination Form that has been made available on the Department Website. Along with the form, they are required to submit 3-4 photographs of the teacher conducting the activity that he/she has been nominated form and a short description of the work done by the teacher. Phone number of SMCs and schools is also asked for verification purpose.
- After this, they are sent to the District Heads for verification and then evaluated by the State Committee
- The best nomination would be chosen by the state and the winner of the award would:
 - Feature on DEE website.
 - Disseminated through SMS and Whatsapp
 - \circ $\;$ Receive Letter of Appreciation from the Director
 - \circ $\,\,$ Be called for presentation at State Review Meetings
 - o (and if the state committee decides) Feature in the newspaper

Achievement: Over 90 nominations for best practices in various categories received.

III. INSTRUCTIONS TO BEEOS/BRCCs FOR NOMINATION:

(1) NOMINATION CRITERIA:

• **Teachers (JBT/TGT/C&V) teaching Class I to VIII** (nominate one teacher in each category)

(2) PROCEDURE:

- There are two types of nominations: Flexible and Scheduled.
- Under scheduled nominations (compulsory), all BRCs have to make **at least 2 nominations (maximum 5)** on any of the categories mentioned above as per the schedule attached.
- Under flexible nomination (optional), the BRCs/BEEOs are free to make any number of nominations at any time. However, sending flexible nominations does not exempt them from sending their scheduled nominations.
- While sending in their nominations, the BRCs are required to fill the Application Form (that will be emailed to them) along with submitting the required proofs.
- The application form has to be emailed at <u>edudata.hp@gmail.com</u>.
- The procedure of sending the necessary proofs is as follows:
 - Submitting 2-3 photos: The images have to be attached along with the application form and emailed at <u>edudata.hp@gmail.com</u> OR whatsapped on the Khaas Shiksha whatsapp group

The name of the image should be 'Name of nominee_1' for the first photo, 'Name of nominee_2 for the second photo and so on. Maximum 3 photographs need to be submitted for one nomination.

• **Enrollment Records**: The records have to be attached along with the application form and emailed at <u>edudata.hp@gmail.com</u>. OR whatsapped on the **Khaas Shiksha** whatsapp group

The name of the image should be 'Name of nominee_1' for the first photo, 'Name of nominee_2' for the second photo and so on. Maximum 3 photographs need to be submitted for one nomination.

- **SMC details**: The details can be filled in the space provided in the <u>Nomination Form</u>.
- The activity nominated should not be more than 12 months old.
