**ADVANCED SCHOOL MANAGEMENT & INTEGRATION SYSTEM (ASMIS)**

Advanced School Management and Integration System (ASMIS) is a mobile and web based application to collect and send data for monitoring and evaluation of the various activities/interventions taken up at the school level for universalization of elementary education in the State of Manipur.

The application has **Geo-Fencing facility**, which permits the application to run only within a radius of 100 meters of the school premises. Schools can instantly upload and update data online/offline. It has 2(two) components-

- (i) Android based Tablets with ASMIS application installed and finger scanner with OTG cable attached.
- (ii) Web based application at the State level.

**Important features of ASMIS:**

**(i) Teacher attendance:**

- Each Teacher's profile data available under U-DISE and also new teacher's profile data unavailable on U-DISE will be updated through this application.
- Daily attendance will be recorded through the finger print scanner attached to the tablet.
- Group photographs of teachers present on a particular day can be captured.

**(ii) Student Data Collection:**

- Each student's data inclusive of parental details, age, sex, address, Aadhaar No. and other particulars can be collected through the application.
- Group photographs of students present on a particular day can also be uploaded.

**(iii) School Management and Development Committee (SMDC):**

- Each and every SMDC Member's details with their photographs can also be uploaded and updated.

**(iv) School Mapping:**

- The Web portal module has the facility to calculate neighborhood distance norms for opening new schools as provided under the RTE Act, 2009

**(v) Scheme/Intervention Monitoring:**

Data and photographs for different interventions under SSA can be uploaded and updated through the application for monitoring and evaluation.

So far 1200 (one thousand two hundred) Government Elementary Schools in the State have been covered.
