CHILD TRACKING

State has under taken a massive data cleaning exercise leading to cleaning of enrolment data. Child tacking, a system for identifying actual enrolment of the children with their Unique ID/Aadhaar Card was introduced and carried out through SDMIS (Student Data Management Information System) In-sync with UDISE 2016-17 in the state.

Out of the total school **3895**, **3890** (99.87%) schools were successfully validated and uploaded online/offline mode. In the state 36% of the children at elementary level were found having Aadhaar, and rest were covered through State Unique ID.

Impact:-

SDMIS exercise for Child tracking had a very positive impact in regard to data cleaning and uploading authentic actual existing children enrolled in schools.

Because of child tacking there has been a fall of 43914 Children at the elementary level (35918 at Primary and 7996 at Upper Primary level) from 2015-16 to 2016-17 in the schools of all management. There is fall of 39159 Children at the elementary level (32200 at Primary and 6959 at Upper Primary level) from 2015-16 to 2016-17 in the Government Schools run by the State Government of Arunachal Pradesh.

Due to the steep decline in enrolment uploaded online/offline under SDMIS, the Educational Indicators shows decline in terms of Transition from 97.26% to 90.23% and Retention from 51.68% to 45.46% at Primary level & 91.05% to 82.97% at UPS level, high Dropout rate from 11.35% to 20.13% at primary level and from 6.5% to 9.3% at upper primary level.

GER (97.03%) & NER (78.10%) at Primary level and GER (85.82%) & NER (64.73%) at Upper Primary level and GER (92.97%) NER (73.25%) at Elementary Level indicated more coverage of authenticate data.

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
