

School Integration

Prior to the session of 2014-15, there were approximately more than 72,000 schools conducted in the state of Rajasthan under the elementary education. After the study of the schools of the state, it was found that many schools were conducted within only 0 to 15 enrollment range. Some schools were being run in one single campus with different names. Separate schools were being run for boys and girls respectively for classes 1 to 5. As a result of this, the state Govt took steps to merge schools

Aims of school Integration

- To merge the schools with less or very low enrolment no. with the nearest schools
- To ensure adequate physical and human infrastructure in schools
- To ensure quality in education
- To ensure ample enrollment with ample teachers in the schools
- To ensure the quality of monitoring in the schools
