## Rajkiyakrit Middle School, Bada Jamda



Middle School Bada Jamda is situated in noamundi block of West Singhbhum district. This area is full with iron ore and it is the border of Odisha. Mr. Rajkumar Shrivastava is the acting Head Master of this school who is recipient of President Award in 2015.

The condition of school before 2012 was very poor. School had no adequate number of class rooms, campus had no boundary and due to situated in the local market area, cleanliness of campus was big issue. There was no running water source and school had only one hand pump. The quality of water was also poor due to iron ore mines area. The water of hand pump was not safe for drinking for the children.

Mr. Shrivastava once decided to mobilize local resources for drinking water. He met Mr. Sanju Kumar Sharda, a Social Worker of this area and shared the problems of drinking water and requested for help. Mr. Sharda assured him and after a week one surveyor team visited school and deep boring with one water tank provided to school in 2012 under CSR activity. Presently school has adequate hygienic water supply.



Mr. Shrivastava and team started working on mobilizing the local resources. They managed one big auditorium of more than 1500 seating capacity and it is provided by another social worker and industrialists Sri Shravan Kumar Sharda on the memory of his Father Late K.P.Sharda. This auditorium is now used by children in various school activities and functions.



Mr. Alok provided 2 solar lights on main gate of School. M/s Loknath Transport has provided two teachers and they are paying honorarium to them.

In this way, school has become model schools. Presently 1300 children are enrolled and average attendance is more than 95%.

This is beginning and still effort is continuing to get more and more facilities by the help of mobilizing local resources.
