Documentation on Seasonal Hostels Kurnool District

It has become unavoidable on the part of certain daily wage labourers to migrate from their native places to faraway places in search of work especially the field labourers of Rayala SeemaRegion in Andhra Pradesh, leave their homes and go away to the places where ever they get better wages for their livelihood. The scene of leaving their homes and their Children shouldering their responsibility on the old age parents is really highly miserable.

SarvaSikshaAbhiyan, extends its heartfelt helping hand to the Children of such migrating labourers. SSA had started the Seasonal Hostels for the sake of these Children so as to replace the affection of their parents. The main aim of these hostels is to take care of the Children of migrant labourers and send them to the nearby Schools. The labourers go on work for four months and they come back. Their Children get food, shelter and academic support in the Seasonal Hostels.

The concept and design of Seasonal Hostels.

The Children in these hostels have a care taker who looks after their well being. There is an instructor who guides them for their academic Progress. Thus the concept and design of the Seasonal Hostel is really a land mark in the system of education. Children of migrant labourers are being highly benefited through these hostels.

The responsibility of organizing the Seasonal Hostels is given to the Self Help group and Non Governmental Organizations verifying their track record of service in earlier Projects. In Adoni division especially at Kodumur, Yemmiganur, Kosig, Kowthalam and Chippagirimandals there are many families which go on migration. So in the I Phase 34 Seasonal Hostels and in the II Phase 30 Seasonal Hostels are sanctioned. More or less sixty Children are residing in each of these hostels.

Children in the Seasonal Hostels attend prayer assembly and early in the morning at 6:30 A.M and then go for study hour.

The Children are taking breakfast and Supper in the week days. They take 3 times food on holidays and on Sundays. In some of the hostels playing material is also supplied so as to make the Children play and enjoy in the evenings. The hand wash with either soap or Dettol is also practiced in these hostels.
