Srinagar to replicate govt school model of Delhi

To improve the infrastructure of schools on the lines of the national Capital, the Srinagar district administration has sent a five-member team to Delhi to study the model of the newly reformed government schools.

The administration wants to change the look of the government schools in Srinagar district.

Deputy Commissioner, Srinagar, Shahid Iqbal Choudhary said after studying the model, the team would implement it in Srinagar. He said the pilot project would start from 20 schools in the



summer capital of the state.

ect in 20 schools. I am only two months old here and we have inspected more than 300 schools which are in a bad condition. Many of them are operating from rented accommodations," the DC said.
