Lucknow: In a first, text and workbooks of classes 1 to 8 of government schools have been made available online. Students can read these books on mobile phones or computers. As many as 32 different text and workbooks prepared by State Council of Educational, Research and Training for UP basic education board have been made available on the Bharatavani portal launched by MHRD. The portal was started in

2016. Students will have to log in to the portal to read the books. Education department officials say Bharatavani website has easy to use interface and provides text, audio, video and image formats of the available material.
