

Kala Utsav begins at Bhavan school with songs event in Chandigarh



The fifth state-level Kala Utsav, 2019, began at Bhavan Vidyalaya, Sector 27, on Tuesday. It would be held till November 22.

Government, government-aided and private schools are participating in the cultural extravaganza. Music vocal had 33 participants, music instrumental 41, dance 37 and painting 58.

The function was inaugurated by education secretary B L Sharma. All the participants participated with full enthusiasm and vigour. The first event was vocal song in which 14 boys and 16 girls participated.
