The boy named Jatin (changed name) was admitted in children home Snehalaya Chandigarh under the category of Orphan and referred by UTCPS and rescued from Govt Medical College Hospital Sect-32 CHD. Child belongs to Ludhiana but resided in Haryana with his Paternal Uncle and he died in Hospital due to heavy fever.

After that he came to Snehalaya as a drop out child and was admitted in class 6<sup>th</sup> in our STC. Sometimes he scored worse. He was not good in studies at his initial stage. But he was a hard working child. I am proud of the way he worked hard.

He was a keen observer and having all qualities like discipline, building relationships, sense of respect, taking responsibility, participating in extra-curricular activities etc. After completing his 2 years in STC he was admitted in GHS Sect-40A. In 2018, child cleared his 10<sup>th</sup> class and got admission in 11<sup>th</sup> class at GMSSS Sect-47 and he secured 63% in 12<sup>th</sup> in this year.

Now, child want to get enroll in diploma in Hotel Management. His admission is under process. He is a good player of Kabaddi and he played at National level at 29<sup>th</sup> Sub-Junior National Kabaddi Championship Boys at Dumka, Jharkhand



He also participates in various activities like Bhangra, Dance, Theatre, Art and Craft and represents Snehalaya Boys.
